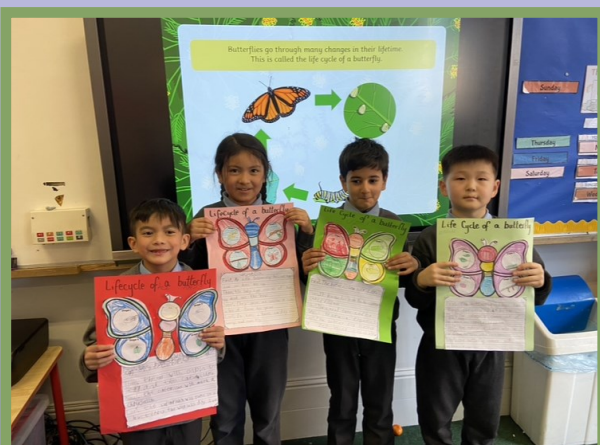
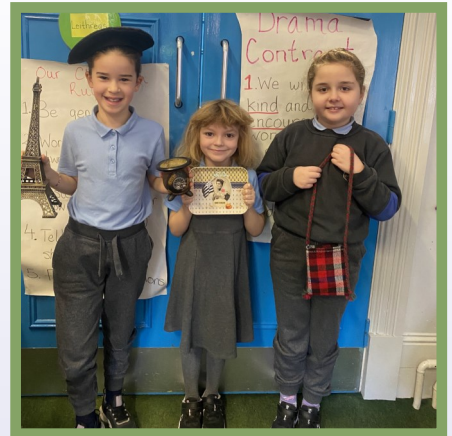
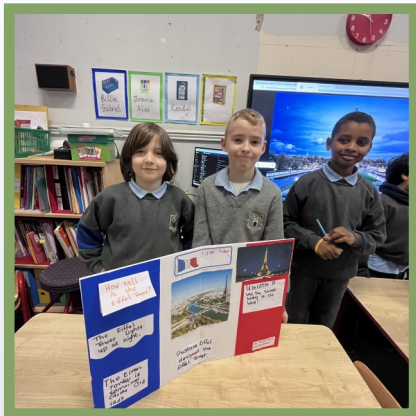

2nd Class: Ms. Dillon, Ms. Sheridan and Ms. Kildee

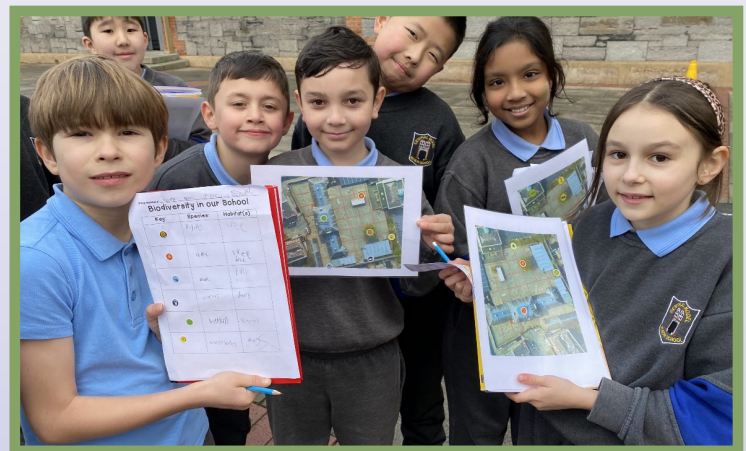
